- A \$35 fee will be charged on all NSF cheques.

FutureStars



FutureStars – Is an introduction to all aspects of figure skating: free skate, ice dance, skating skills and interpretive skating. This program has been designed to fill the gap between CanSkate and StarSkate. This program is taught by Club Coaches and Program Assistants. It is recommended that a skater have completed stage 3 or have permission from the program manager. **All skaters must wear properly fitted figure skates and a CSA hockey helmet until stage 5 is complete.**

Progress will be accelerated if your skater skates two or more times a week and has private lessons. Private and semi-private lessons may take place at any time and are to be arranged and discussed with your private coach.
