**FutureStars** – Is an introduction to all aspects of figure skating: free skate, ice dance, skating skills and interpretive skating. This program has been designed to fill the gap between CanSkate and StarSkate. This program is taught by Club Coaches and Program Assistants. It is recommended that a skater have completed stage 3 or have permission from the program manager. **All skaters must wear properly fitted figure skates and a CSA hockey helmet until stage 5 is complete.**

Progress will be accelerated if your skater skates two or more times a week and has private lessons. Private and semi-private lessons may take place at any time and are to be arranged and discussed with your private coach. All registered DSC Home Club FutureStars must participate in the DSC mandatory Fundraising Activities each year. During the 2018-2019 season, all FutureStars will be selling SportSweep tickets. FutureStars will each be receiving 3 books of tickets (30 tickets) for the Fall Session and 3 books of tickets for the winter season. The Mandatory sales amount is \$60.00 per season and is due with registration payments. All funds raised through ticket sales will be retained by the skater.
