CanSkate is Skate Canada's flagship learn-to-skate program, designed for beginners of all ages. When you sign up for CanSkate you will be in a program that focuses on fun, participation and basic skill development. You will earn badges and other incentives as you learn fundamental skating skills for **figure skating, hockey, ringette and recreational skating**. Lessons are given in a group format and led by an NCCP certified professional coach. Professional coaches are assisted by trained Program Assistants.

Canskate sessions are for children ages 3.5 -11.

Skaters will need properly fitted skates. Try to avoid plastic molded skates and do not remove picks from figure skates. CSA approved hockey helmets are required for stages 1- 5.
